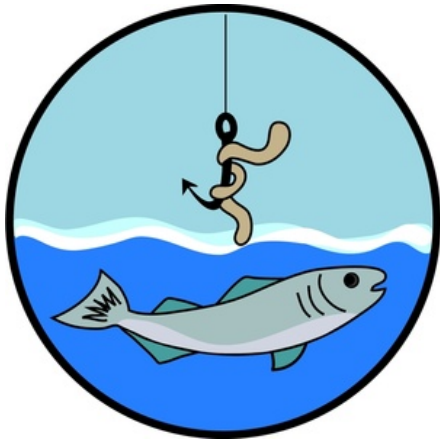

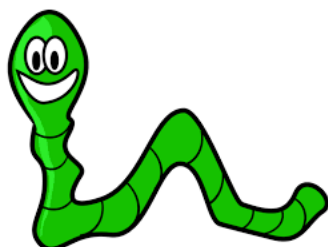
Exploring Farm Animals

Limits are placed on camps due to transportation availability, staffing, and space restrictions.

The following events require additional paperwork or information and/or have special requirements: Southeast District 4-H Horse Show, District Activity Day, NC 4-H Citizenship Focus, 4-H Camp, and NC 4-H Congress NCAYCC Youth Summit.

Please come by the Lenoir County Cooperative Extension office to register, pay, and fill out forms to complete the registration process. Enrollment forms, medical release forms, and a signed Code of Conduct must be on file to reserve a spot for your child.

All registration fees are NON-REFUNDABLE. Fees are used to cover supplies, food, insurance, and transportation to keep events at the lowest cost possible. Registration fees will be returned if camp is cancelled.
