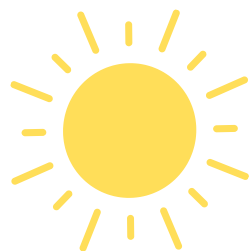

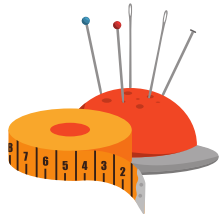

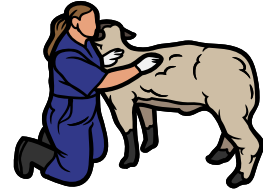
LIVESTOCK SCIENCE CAMP

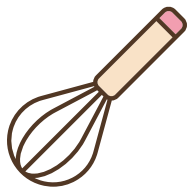

MOOVING MILK!

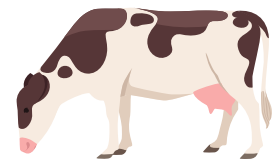


Age: 5-10

All registration fees are NON-REFUNDABLE. Fees are used to cover supplies, insurance, and transportation to keep events at the lowest cost possible. Registration fees will be returned if camp is cancelled.
