

# SIGN UP!

Lenoir County 4-H Summer programs are available to youth ages 5-18 as of January 1, 2023.

To sign up, these steps must be completed:

1. Enroll in 4-H Online.

2. Completed registration form and payment turned in at extension office.

Enrollment in the 4-H Online system is REQUIRED for all participants prior to registration. Youth WILL NOT be added to programs unless they are in the 4-H Online System. Enroll at v2.4honline.com

Register for camps in person at the Lenoir County Cooperative Extension Office, Monday - Friday 8:30a-5:00p.




